## Floor - Arena RULES & GUIDELINES

- 1. Competitor and model must be at least 16 years of age.
- 2. There is no smoking, vaping or eating on the competition floor.
- 3. Competitors and their models may choose to have a bottle of water for hydration.
- 4. Please be considerate of other competitors and keep chit chat quiet and between you and your model only.
- 5. Competitors who are not currently competing are not to be on the arena floor.
- 6. The setup of workstations is only to be done during the allocated times, please see comp day schedule.
- 7. You may choose to leave the arena between competitions but if you are staying in the competition arena you must stay seated at your station.
- 8. Competitors not understanding English must provide their own translator.
- 9. Only competitors and models are allowed to enter the competition floor. However, translators are allowed to enter when necessary.
- 10. Competition categories will have a briefing 15 minutes prior to the start of the competition. It is encouraged that all competitors and models be present for the briefing.
- 11. Model's nails will be checked by the floor judge to be certain no application has been done prior to the start of the competition. If product is found on the nail the competitor will receive a 5-point deduction to their final score.
- 12. Once the competition has begun competitors or their models are not to retrieve any extra items from their kit. All product and necessary equipment must be on the table prior to the commencement of the competition.
- 13. All products on the table during the competition must be clearly labeled. Hand- written labels are acceptable.
- 14. Each competitor will be supplied with 2 electric out-lets.
- 15. Competitors must bring necessary electrical supplies, including UV/LED lamps, extension cords, adapters, electrical files.
- 16. Competitors must provide all necessary nail products and tools needed to create their competition set.
- 17. Once the allocated time has been called. competitors must immediately stop working and put their hands up.
- 18. Competitors caught touching their models hands after time has been called will receive a 10-point deduction off their final score.
- 19. If the model is caught touching the nails while waiting to be judged, the competitor will receive a 5 point deduction.
- 20. It is the competitor and their models responsibility to ensure they have been judged by all judges.
- 21. In the event of a tie or of any disputes to the scoring, it will be up to the discretion of the head judge to make a ruling.
- 22. The head judge's decision is final.
- 23. Competitors are responsible for obtaining their own model
- 24. Models can not be a practice hand.
