- 1. New Zealand Nail Competition is open to all qualified, certified and currently in training Nail Technicians.
- 2. New Zealand Nail Competition reserves the right to refuse entry to any competitor.
- 3. As a Competitor of the New Zealand Nail Competition, you agree to follow all rules and guidelines set out by the competition and its event organizers. Intentional misuse or disregard to the rules and guidelines will be in violation of our terms and conditions, resulting in an instant disqualification. Extreme cases will face a temporary to permanent ban.
- 4. New Zealand Nail Competition is not responsible for any competitor not adhering to or understanding all the rules.
- 5. Competitors not understanding English must provide their own translator.
- 6. The competitor must enter the highest division they qualify for. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they have entered into the correct division.
- 7.No photos or posts naming or identifying work done for or in the competition arena on any social media platform or in any large group chat until after the end of prize giving. It is important that all judging is done with integrity and without bias.
- 8. Video and photo content will be taken by NZ Nail Competition for promotional purposes, including but not limited to; social media, physical publications, website -which may include your image or that of your work. By entering NZ Nail Comps, you consent its use, unless you specifically request in writing that your image is not be used for this purpose. Submissions can be made to hello@nznailcomp.com
- 9. Competitors and their modes are expected to act in a respectful way towards all New Zealand nail competition guests and associates.
- 10. Competitor and model must be at least 16 years of age.
- 11. Competitors must provide all necessary nail products and tools needed to create their competition set.
- 12. In the event of a tie or of any disputes to the scoring, it will be up to the discretion of the head judge to make a ruling.
- 13. The head judge's decision is final.
- Score sheets will be made available for all competitors.
- 14. New Zealand Nail Competition is under no physical or financial responsibility to get unclaimed medals, prizes or artwork to competitors. Although we will do our best to be accommodating where possible.
- 15. All competition divisions must have a minimum of 3 competitors. If less than 3 competitors have entered, the competitor may choose to enter into a division in the next highest division or to pull out and receive a refund of their competition fees minus administration costs.
- 16. In the event that a competition only has 3 competitors only 1st place will be awarded.
- 17. As a Competitor you understand and agree that upon paying entry into New Zealand Nail Competition, that the event organizers are committing time and resources to process and run this event. That withdrawal from the competition would result in loss of income and potential loss of other entries in an amount difficult to precisely calculate. Therefore, the following cancellation limitations will apply
